



Outdoor fabrics pass 1500 hrs of light fastness and have an anti-bacterial finish. Below is a description of the anti-bacterial finish and cleaning instructions.

What is Anti- Bacterial Finish?

The anti-bacterial finish passes both AATCC 100 and 30 standardized tests which demonstrate the finish kills both fungus and bacteria. This is the same finish used on hospital curtains which divides patient space in emergency rooms and other hospital applications. It is durable and withstands up to 50 launderings in hospital laundries.

Outdoor Cleaning Instructions:

Normal Stains/Dirt – Remove loose dirt with soft bristle brush or lightly hose down with cold water. Clean with mixture of water and mild detergent (Ivory Snow or Woolite) - two capfuls of detergent per gallon of water. Be liberal with solution and scrub with soft brush. Rinse thoroughly with clean, cold water and air dry. Do not machine dry.

Stubborn Stains/Dirt - Remove as much surface dirt as possible. Suntan oil and lotions should be promptly removed. Clean with mixture of water and mild detergent (Ivory Snow or Woolite) - two capfuls of detergent per gallon of water. Be liberal with solution and scrub with soft brush. Rinse thoroughly with clean, cold water and air dry. Do not machine dry.
